Valet Parking Services to Begin

The booth has arrived and valet services will begin Monday, October 14 (see photo). Parking Solutions will handle the free valet service, which will be located just outside the temporary new entrance on the south side of the building. Initial hours of operation will be 6 a.m. - 8 p.m. Monday through Friday. Valet hours will be adjusted as usage requires.

Watch for Power Line Work

Watch for traffic pattern changes in the south parking lot this week. A new underground utility line will be installed that will run across the south parking lot (east to west) to the sidewalk in front of the Pavilion. This installation will not require a power shutdown.

Parking Lot Updates

The new employee parking lot on Harmon Avenue is being finished up this week and will provide 50 parking spaces (see photo). Additional employee parking will be marked off (roughly 30 spaces) in the parking lot to the immediate south of the Kroger parking lot. The parking lot to the south of the Accounting Building also will be

available for auxiliary employee parking. Lastly, the existing student parking lot on Ewing Street, which has 38 parking spaces, will be switched to an employee parking lot during construction, as well. There have been questions regarding the shuttling of employees to remote parking lots: There is no plan to shuttle employees. Shuttle service

will be provided to students, taking them to and from a designated shuttle parking lot off East Main Street. To address questions surrounding security and night parking, this service will only be necessary during the day and therefore should not pose a security issue.

Every measure is being taken to protect the security of employees throughout Project BRIGHT. There will be plenty of call parking in the areas where staff currently park. In addition, every staff parking location will have a camera that will cover the parking lot. The longest walk will be from the lot beside of the Accounting Building; however, this lot should only be used for day-shift parking.


In the next couple of weeks, a map will be distributed that will have all of the parking lots labeled and will contain an index indicating where staff are allowed to park. In addition, all of the lots will have signs to direct staff to the correct place. Fencing will not go up until Oct. 21, which is when employee parking will be most affected.

Harmon Avenue Traffic Pattern Changes

Throughout Project BRIGHT, Harmon Avenue will be used for construction traffic only. This means staff will not be able to turn onto Harmon Avenue from East Main Street or access East Main Street from Harmon Avenue. However, there will be limited access off Harmon Avenue for employees to enter the new parking lot located next to the VNA building. Staff will enter from Ewing Street and then use the alley that runs by the Pavilion to access Harmon and then turn into the parking lot. Again, there will be maps distributed in the near future that will show the routes for staff to access parking.

BRIGHT Pathways

Start looking for bright yellow pedestrian pathways to be painted on the parking lot pavement. A pathway leading from the Pavilion to the temporary new entrance will be painted next week to help ensure the safety of pedestrian traffic throughout the project.



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
