DR. RON LINEHAN, MD, OPENS PRECISION PAIN CARE IN LANCASTER

LANCASTER, Ohio (December 1, 2008) – Dr. Ron Linehan, MD, has opened Precision Pain Care, a new pain care practice in Lancaster. Precision Pain Care is located in the Riverview Medical Office Building, one block east of the U.S. 33 Business Route, just north of downtown Lancaster. The location of Precision Pain Care will be familiar to Dr. Linehan's current patients, as he has worked from the same building for the last seven years as a member of a group practice. "I wanted to establish new standards of patient care, and to provide more prompt, attentive and precise treatment for all my patients. Precision Pain Care allows me the flexibility I need to achieve those goals."



Dr. Linehan is a member of the Medical Staff at Fairfield Medical Center, and treats most patients with minimally invasive pain reduction techniques. These state-of-the-art methods require very short recovery times, and patients often experience an almost immediate reduction in pain. With a follow-up course of physical therapy, chiropractic, or other rehabilitative therapies, many patients can return to their pre-injury activity levels.

Dr. Linehan is certified by the American Board of Anesthesiology and holds a Subspecialty Certification in Pain Management. He is also a diplomate of the American Board of Pain Medicine. He is certified in Spinal Cord Stimulator Placement, Percutaneous Discectomy, Vertebroplasty, and Radiofrequency Ablation. Additionally, Dr. Linehan practices general anesthesiology at Fairfield Medical Center. He also volunteers with Operation Smile, a non-profit organization providing

reconstructive facial surgery for children; and with the International Cardiac Care Foundation (ICCF) where he provides anesthesiology services for heart surgery patients in developing countries.

He received his M.D. from the University of Tennessee College of Medicine and performed his internship at The Jewish Hospital in Cincinnati. He completed his Anesthesiology residency at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center and Children's Hospital Medical Center. After residency, he practiced pain management in Kentucky and Tennessee before moving to Lancaster in 1998.
