In addition, each child participating in the bike race must wear a helmet, and each bicycle must have brakes.

- 6:00 p.m. – Bike-decorating contest.
- 6:30 p.m. - Sprint style races for children ages 10 and under.
- 7:15 p.m. - The presentation of awards will be held at the band stand stage. Prizes awarded to the top 3 winners in each age category.

Judging for the bike-decorating contest will begin at 6:00 p.m., and the races will follow at 6:30. The age groups this year are 4 and younger, 5-6, 7-8 and 9-10. Awards will be given to each winner in both a boys and girls category at the stage at 7:15 p.m.
