## From the desk of Irving Rosenberg, MD, Internal Medicine Program Director at Fairfield Medical Center

Thank you for considering Fairfield Medical Center as your residency program in Internal Medicine. You can (if you haven't already) read the welcome from our Director of Medical Education, Dr. Troy Hampton, and watch the video describing the program on the Graduate Medical Education portion of the FMC website. I want to share some statistics with you regarding our graduates of the program since its inception in 2012.

- We have an 83% overall graduation rate (3 transferred to specialty programs, 1 non-renewal of contract and 1 dismissal).
- We have an 84% overall board certification pass rate on the 1<sup>st</sup> attempt for those that have taken their board certification exam.
- Out of our first 3 classes of graduates, 5 residents were in the startup of our Hospitalist group at FMC and are still Hospitalists here today. Since then, we have added 1 more resident to this Hospitalist group.
- 6 graduates have attended or are currently attending Fellowships; 1 in Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine, 2 in Nephrology, 2 in Rheumatology and 1 in Sleep Medicine.
- 16 graduates have stayed in Ohio and are working in outpatient clinics or as Hospitalists. 1 of these graduates has returned to help out in the IM Continuity Clinic for the IM residency program.
- The Internal Medicine Residency Program has had 33 graduates to date; 48% have stayed in Ohio to practice medicine, with 3 still in Fellowship programs.
