Medications that you will need

A prescription for Suflave will be sent to your pharmacy. Please follow the directions below when taking your Suflave prep. If your pharmacy does not receive this prescription, please call the office at: ______.

A stool softener will be ordered by the doctor's office. This may be called into the pharmacy or samples may be given to you. You will need to start taking this medication seven (7) days before your colonoscopy.

How to take medications for colonoscopy

Seven (7) days **BEFORE** your colonoscopy

Start taking the stool softener ordered by your doctor's office. Follow the directions on the bottle/package.

FOLLOW THE FOOD SUGGESTIONS BELOW

- Do not eat nuts, seeds, dried fruits, dried bean and peas
- Limit whole grain foods
- Choose cooked or canned fruits and vegetables over fresh ones
- Choose white bread and white rice
- Drink juices without pulp
- Eat tender, well cooked meats

Two (2) days **BEFORE** your colonoscopy

Only eat foods listed below for the two (2) days before your colonoscopy

- Water
- Coffee with NO creamer
- Tea with NO creamer
- Broth (beef, chicken or vegetable) (no meat, noodle or vegetable pieces)
- Apple or white grape juice
- Sprite, ginger ale and 7-Up
- Gatorade or PowerAde (no red, blue or purple)
- Popsicles (no red, blue or purple)
- Jell-O (no red, blue or purple)

If you are diabetic, please buy sugar free options

One (1) day **BEFORE** your colonoscopy

Continue clear liquid diet as explained above.

Colonoscopy Suflave 2-day Prep



At 6 p.m.

- 1. Prepare your Suflave mixture: Open one Suflave packet and pour contents into provided bottle.
- 2. Fill provided bottle with lukewarm water up to the fill line. After capping the bottle, gently shake the bottle until all powder has dissolved. Refrigerate the solution for an hour prior to drinking. Do not freeze. Use within 24 hours.
- 3. Drink eight (8) ozs. of Suflave mixture in bottle every 15 minutes until the bottle is empty.
- 4. Drink an additional 16 ozs. of water during the evening.

If drinking the Suflave mixture makes you sick to your stomach you can try drinking it slower. Some nausea and bloating is normal.

On the day of your colonoscopy

Five (5) hours before the time of your colonoscopy

Example: If your colonoscopy is scheduled for 9 a.m. you should start drinking your Suflave prep at 4 a.m. It should be finished by 6 a.m. Do **NOT** drink **ANYTHING** after 7 a.m.

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- 2. Fill provided bottle with lukewarm water up to the fill line. After capping the bottle, gently shake the bottle until all powder has dissolved. Refrigerate the solution for an hour prior to drinking. Do not freeze. Use within 24 hours.
- 3. Drink eight (8) ozs. of Suflave mixture in bottle every 15 minutes until the bottle is empty.
- 4. Drink an additional 16 ozs. of water during the morning.
 - Stop drinking liquids at least two (2) hours prior to colonosopy.
 - If drinking the Suflave mixture makes you sick to your stomach you can try drinking it slower. Some nausea and bloating is normal.

You cannot have anything to eat or drink **EXCEPT** your Suflave prep on the morning of your colonoscopy.

You can take your medications with a sip of water the day of your colonoscopy unless told not to take them by your doctor.

Be sure to have finished your Suflave prep and taken your medications at least two (2) hours before your colonoscopy. You should have **NOTHING** to drink two (2) hours before your colonoscopy.

Things to remember

- Reminder: You cannot have anything to eat or drink (including water) the day of your procedure except your bowel prep and a small sip of water to take your medicine.
- Someone has to drive you to the hospital, stay at the hospital until you are done and drive
 you home. You cannot drive the day of your colonoscopy. If you do not have someone to
 do these things, your colonoscopy will be cancelled.
- If you take an iron supplement, stop taking them five (5) days before your procedure to avoid discoloration of your stool.
- The office will let you know which of your medications need to be stopped and for how long. Some of the most commonly adjusted medications include blood thinners and diabetic medications. Medication instructions:

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- If drinking the Suflave mixture makes you sick to your stomach you can try drinking it slower. Some nausea and bloating is normal.
- Your poop should be all liquid. It should not be brown in color. It should look clear to yellow. You will need to reschedule if it does not look like this the morning of your colonoscopy.
- If you need to cancel your colonoscopy you will need to call your doctor's office.
